PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The nonprofit organization Grand Street Guild is constructing a 232-unit 100% truly affordable residential development at 165 Broome Street, on the corner of Clinton Street in Manhattan.

COMPLETED WORK:

- Old parking garage demolished and the construction site leveled to grade
- Construction fencing in place; Support of excavation piling
- Vibration & other monitoring equipment installed
- Dewatering System installed
- Temporary access ramp behind 410 Grand Street

UPCOMING WORK NEXT MONTH:

- Foundation concrete work in progress
- Underground plumbing and electrical work in progress
- Start of 2nd phase of temporary walkway to Grand Street
- Start of installation of sidewalk bridge & overhead protection

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm,
Saturday 8am to 4:30pm.

CONSTRUCTION SITE:

All work including health and safety protocols on site has been approved in advance by the relevant NYC regulatory agencies, including the NYC Department of Buildings.

CONSTRUCTION EFFECTS:

Grand Street Guild and Monadnock Construction are committed to maintaining a work site that is both safe and clean. We ask for your patience and understanding during times of construction activities.

This month, you can expect the following:

- Truck deliveries within hours of operation.
- Signs, advisories, and temporary construction barriers to guide traffic and pedestrians and promote safety.
- For concrete pour days, work hours may be extended.
